What is a Lazar and Katherine Scharhon Memorial Scholarship? It is a one year, \$5,000 scholarship given to child of an SBH Member graduating High School based on scholarship, character, and community service. The scholarship goes towards one year education in Israel (i.e. yeshiva, seminary, university, or college).

APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP AWARD 2023

INSTRUCTIONS: *READ CAREFULLY*

Must be a high school senior graduate, a child of a SBH member about to enter a yeshiva, seminary, university, or college in Israel. For any questions or information about this scholarship contact Rabbi Hassan or the Committee chairperson Esther Morhaime.

1. This scholarship is for 1st year entering yeshiva, seminary, university, or college in Israel .
2. The scholarship is only for a child of an SBH Members.
3. Scholarships will ultimately **NOT** be granted unless proof of enrollment and acceptance for the upcoming first year in yeshiva, seminary, university, or college in Israel has been received by the Scholarship Committee.
4. Each applicant **MUST** request that transcripts be sent by his or her high school, directly to email: scholarship@scharhon.com . Further, it is each applicant's obligation to confirm with scholarship@scharhon.com whether such transcripts have been received.
5. You will need to write an essay **in your own words** about yourself and who you see yourself as in the future. The letter will be crucial so give it your all and lots of thought.
6. You will need one recommendation from someone **other than** family, or Rabbi Hassan.

SUBMISSION

1. You must submit a completed application, high school transcript, personal essay, one recommendation, and proof of acceptance for the upcoming first year in a yeshiva, seminary, university, or college in Israel to scholarship@scharhon.com in order to receive your scholarship.
2. Applicants must be a graduating senior in high school at the time their application is submitted.

DEADLINES

APPLICATIONS AND OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS must be **RECEIVED** by **March 31, 2023** (sent by email to scholarship@scharhon.com). Late applications will be returned unopened.

What Happens Next? All submissions received by no later than the submission date will be numbered and all names will be redacted, so it becomes a blind submission to the Scholarship Awards Committee. The committee is composed of 3 people who will remain anonymous. The committee members will individually receive the blind submissions to read and review on their own. They will then meet to discuss and render their decision. The award will be presented at a date to be announced. If you are chosen, your check will be issued to the named institution once proof of admission, enrollment, and bill is received.
